
AN INVITATION...



DISTRICT CONVENTION REPORT...

The 39th convention of the Colorado District of the LCMS met at the School of Mines in Golden on June 10-13. In attendance were 122 lay delegates, 108 pastoral delegates, 76 advisory delegates and 35 youth delegates. Lou Volberding and I represented Concordia.

In election action, the Rev. Ralph Phipps was reelected as President of the Colorado District. Elected as Vice Presidents were the Rev. Martin Hartenberger of Albuquerque, N.M. (1st VP); the Rev. John Petersen of Fort Monanta Co. (2nd VP); and the Rev. William Naatz of Denver, Co. (3rd VP). Lected to the Board of Directors from our region were the Rev. Donald Berg of Ogden, Utah; Mr. George Gohlinghorst of Salt Lake City, Utah; and Mr. Clayton Melby of Cortez, Col.

Among the resolutions passed were the following:

- -to commend and encourage Campus Ministry within the District;
- -to commend our District's mission staff;
- -to develop more effective youth ministry in the District;
- -to encourage a strong congregation Stewardship program;
- -to encourage the congregations of the District to give a special offering to help reduce the Synod's debt;
- -to name the District the Rocky Mountain District (because it includes also New Mexico, Utah, and parts of Texas and Nebraska)
- -to support St. John's College in its recruitment of students for church-related professions;
- -to urge congregations to use the new Synod hymnal, Lutheran Wor-ship;
- -to inform the members of our congregations about the dangers of Casino gambling and to encourage the groups working against Casino gambling in Colorado;
- -to request the Board of Lutheran Social Services to consider revising its guidelines on abotion;
- -to revise the District's bylaws in various areas to bring them in line with the new Synodical structure (e.g. trienniel conventions; 3-year terms for District officials) and to enhance ministry within our District.

A book reporting all the resolutions and actions of the convention will be sent out by the District office later this summer. You are welcome to read it when it comes and/or to talk with Lou Volberding or myself about the convention. From time-to-time you may hear more about specific resolutions as we deal with them here at Concordia.

Enjoy the rest of your summer. I look forward to seeing you at worship!


