WHERE: The Community Center (by the Bud Werner Library)


WHEN: Reformation Sunday, October 30th, at 6:00 p.m.


HOW: A Pot-Luck Supper with a German theme

REFORMATION EXCITEMENT...

On October 31, 1517, hammer blows were struck that literally shook the world. On that day, Dr. Martin Luther nailed his 95 Theses to the church door in Wittenberg, Germany. Luther was looking for a debate on these 95 issues, but it was this action that is heralded as the beginning of the Reformation.

As we worship on Reformation Sunday, we will celebrate the 466th anniversary of Luther's action in Wittenberg as well

as the 500th anniversary of Luther's birth (Nov. 10, 1483).

As always, we will worship the Triune God: the Father who has created and preserved us; the Son who has redeemed us; and the Holy Spirit who has brought us to faith in Jesus Christ and keeps us in this faith. We will rejoice that Luther fought to preserve the pure, clear Gospel message of salvation for Christ's sake through faith.

We do not have to pay penance, or buy indulgences, or say rosaries, or spend time working-off our sins in purgatory. We have God's Promise that thru faith in Jesus as our Savior we have forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation -- beginning now and continuing into eternity.

The excitement of Reformation Sunday comes from knowing, beyond a shadow of a doubt, that we are God's people through Christ. We have been baptized. We are forgiven. We don't live in fear, but in freedom. In Christ we are free to worship, free to give thanks and praise, and free to give of our time, talents, and treasure for the Lord's Kingdom. We look at what God has done for us; then we look for ways in which we can serve.

Join your fellow Christians for worship on Reformation Sunday. Then come to the Marty Party that evening and enjoy the fellowship of your brothers and sisters in Christ.


