### SUMMER - TIME...



A Pittsburgh consulting firm spent more than a year studying how much time people spend doing different things in a lifetime. They found that most people spend: one year searching for misplaced objects; six years eating; eight months opening junk mail; and two years trying to call people who never seem to be in.

They also discovered that the fastest fast-food came out of the windows of Wendy's (who could deliver a hamburger, fries and drink in only 46 seconds). McDonald's was 1½ minutes; and Burger King trailed at 3 minutes.

At home, interviews of 1000 married people revealed that the average married couple spends four minutes a day in meaningful conversation, and that the working couple spends 30 seconds a day talking with their children. "Most people say their families are important," Priority Management's president says, "but they don't live that way."
