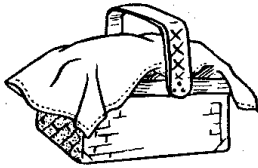

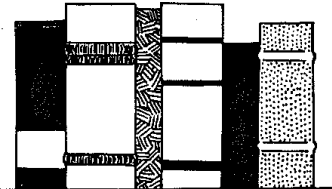

HELP STILL NEEDED FOR LANDSCAPING...

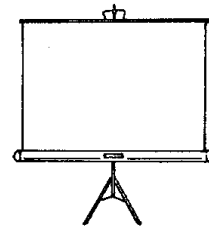

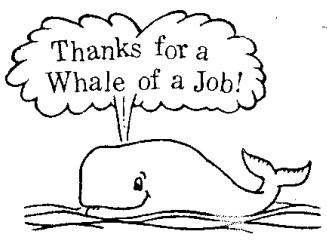
LWML / GUILD NOTES...

COME TO THE DIVINE DRAMA!!



Everybody enjoys a drama. The twists and turns of the story keep us on the edge of our seats as we wonder how it will all turn out. We might identify with a character in the drama and see ourselves in the story.

THE DIVINE DRAMA takes place on planet Earth, and Jesus Christ, the Savior and Servant-King, is at the center of the stage. He is the Lord of all creation and the key to history. In grace, the Father gathers the community called the Church around His Son. The members of that gathered community are summoned to praise their Redeemer-King, and live for others as He lived for them.

You are invited to study THE DIVINE DRAMA with me beginning in September. This is a 30-session course (September through May) which will meet on Thursday evenings for an hour-and-a-half. We are so happy to see our SUMMER FRIENDS from Arizona and other states. Please help them to feel at home at Concordia.



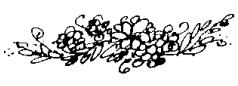
We are happy that FLORENCE VOLBERDING AND TIFFANY YOUNG have been able to return to Steamboat after their hospital stays in Denver.

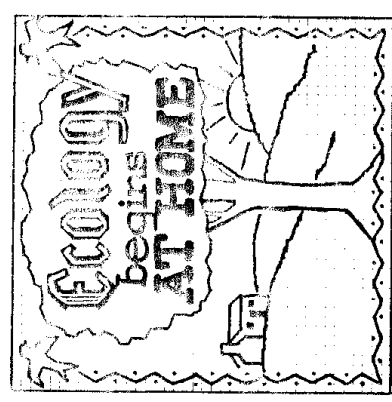
