GREETINGS IN THE NAME OF OUR ADVENT KING!

"Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star in the East and have come to worship him." (Matt.2:2)

I heard an advertisement on the radio the other day offering a very unique Christmas present costing only \$35.00. Just send a check or money-order to the "official" star naming company. They will then pick a star for you and name it after you. They then send you an astronomical sky map which details out for you where your star is located. \$35.00 dollars for your own star. What a deal!

During the Christmas/Advent season I occasionally gaze heavenward during the dark night hours. I look for bright stars during Advent. I try to imagine what it would be like to locate "the star in the East" which must have totally captivated the Wise men.

But then I become a bit somber. Only a few (traditionally three) wise persons recognized the sign in the sky of the coming Savior. So few recognized that the Mèssiah had indeed come. The Holy Word of God was (and still is) a huge floodlight pointing the way...but so few recognized!

A brilliant star named Jesus, Christ, Messiah, Almighty God, Savior, Wonderful Counselor sparkled above the sleepy Bethlehem hamlet. That light focused on a stable....on a manger...on a child. A pinpoint of light made its way through the layers of swaddling clothes. There, having come into a dark world, was the light of the world.

Suddenly, one realizes that things are reversed. It wasn't that the light of the star in the East was shining down on some poor Jewish baby in a manger. But, that from the heart of this God-child there arose a mighty beam of light. It illumined the star...the sky. The light of the world claimed a star and directed the wise men to Bethlehem.

That light is still shining. It is a ray of hope, love and forgiveness. It is a beacon of salvation in a sin-dark world. That light still shines from our Lord. It was a risen Lord that brilliantly burst forth from the grave! The darkness of sin (our sin), death (our death), and the devil has been dispelled! That is the "son-shine" of Advent.

#### BAPTIZED CHRIST INTO


- You are incorporated into Christ and into his body, the church.
