

Brief Bio for Pastor Dave



Pastor:

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

People: A

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, the Reverend David McKnight has been called to be the pastor of Concordia Lutheran Congregation. Hear now what Holy Scripture says concerning the office of public

ministry.

READING FROM SCRIPTURE

Pastor:

Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I will be with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28:18-20)

Pastor:

Dear brother in Christ, the Lord grant that you receive and keep these words in your heart that you may be strengthened and encouraged in your labors.

God gathers His Church by and around His Holy Word and also grants it growth and increase. That this may be done, He has established the office of the public ministry into which you were ordained. It is fitting that you would again acknowledge the responsibilities of this holy office in which you are to serve this congregation. In the presence of God and this congregation, I now ask you:

Do you believe the canonical books of the Old and New Testaments to be the inspired Word of God and the only infallible rule of faith and practice?

Pastor McKnight: I do.

Pastor:

Do you accept the three Ecumenical Creeds, namely, the Apostles', the Nicene, and the Athanasian Creeds as faithful testimonies to the truth of the Holy Scriptures, and do you reject all the errors which they condemn?

Pastor McKnight: I do.

Pastor:

Do you believe that the Unaltered Augsburg Confession is a true exposition of the Word of God and a correct exhibition of the doctrine of the Evangelical Lutheran Church; that the Apology of the Augsburg Confession, the Small and Large Catechisms of Martin Luther, the Smalcald Articles, the Treatise on the Authority and Primacy of the Pope, and the Formula of Concord — as these are contained in the Book of Concord — are also in agreement with this one scriptural faith?

Pastor McKnight: I do.

Pastor:

Do you solemnly promise that you will perform the duties of your office in accordance with these Confessions, or Symbols, and that all your teaching and your administration of the sacraments will be in conformity with the Holy Scriptures and with the aforementioned Symbols?

Pastor McKnight: I do.

Pastor:

Will you faithfully instruct both young and old in the chief articles of Christian doctrine; will you forgive the sins of those who repent, and will you promise never to divulge the sins confessed to you; will you minister faithfully to the sick and dying; will you demonstrate to the Church a constant and ready ministry, admonishing the people to a lively confidence in Christ and holy living?

Pastor McKnight: I will, with the help of God.

Pastor: Finally, will you adorn the office of the public ministry with a holy life?

Pastor McKnight: I will, the Lord helping me through the power and grace of His Holy Sprit.
