Happy December

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

This is truly one of my favorite times of the year. It seems my joy grows each year as I work through the Scriptures that show how God demonstrates His love for us in sending Jesus into our world to be our Savior. And I get excited about worshipping with all of you as well.

This year the messages for our Advent Sundays spring from the Old Testament...but not necessarily passages and events you would normally relate to Christmas. We are focusing on learning to be patient and to wait for the Lord. That's a lesson God's people of old needed as much as we do today.

Christmas music is also a favorite of mine. I truly love solid Christmas carols. I agree with Martin Luther who felt that next to the written and spoken word – music is the greatest tool for communicating the Gospel. Some of the Christmas carols we know and love have amazing "back stories". This year our Midweek Advent services will focus on some of the well-known Christmas carols...and the stories behind them. I invite you to join us on Wednesdays for soup and worship, and on Sundays for Advent worship.

I am particularly excited about our Christmas Eve services this year. We will have Candlelight worship services at 5:30pm / 7:30pm / and 9:30pm. The 9:30pm service will also offer Holy Communion. This year's theme is: "A Baby Changes Everything". We will sing, explore the Christmas Gospel, and enjoy some special music as we focus on how the Christ Child truly changes everything. Two friends of mine created a "palindrome" that we will see on video as a part of the service. A palindrome is something that says the same thing when it is read forwards and backwards. I think you'll appreciate the meaning behind their creation.

Because Christmas Eve/Christmas Day is a Friday-Saturday event, the Worship Committee chose to have one worship service on Sunday, December 26th. Also, because of Christmas travel, they decided to do the same on January 2nd. So, on both of those Sundays we will have one worship service at 9:00am. Both of those services will include Holy Communion.

In January, I plan to begin a 10-week discussion /study of the "10 Suggestions...oops...I meant the 10 Commandments." The study will meet on Sunday mornings between services. As a part of that study, we would like to make available to anyone who participates and who desires it, a new copy of "Luther's Small Catechism". Watch for the sign-up sheet for that class to appear in the entryway of church in the coming weeks.

I am looking forward to seeing you all in worship!
