Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

"Family Values" seems to be an oft quoted subject in political campaigns. Politicians and parties play tug of war with them. Everybody says that we need them, but nobody is defining them. William Bennett, who served as Secretary of Education from 1985 – 1988, wrote: "It's now politically correct to believe in family values, but it's not politically correct to get specific about them." The reason is that when you get specific, you start dividing people up. There are all kinds of families, and a lot of different values. Is there somewhere we can go to get some solid help here?

Thousands of years ago, God gave 10 values for family living. They are called "the 10 Commandments." In fact, we have a Bible study going on them right now between services. Kids learn about them in Sunday School and Confirmation.

In the United States they are a bedrock of our civilization. They serve as part of the foundation upon which we have built our laws. The 10 commandments are accepted by Jews and Christians, and even Muslims. Many have learned the basics about them.
