# "Learning, Living, Sharing the Gospel"

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Edward Kimball was concerned about one of his young Sunday School students who worked at a shoe store in town. One day, he visited him at the store, found the student in the back room stocking shelves, and led him to Christ right there. The student was Dwight L. Moody who eventually became a great preacher and evangelist.

Moody, who became in international speaker, was in the British Isles, and preached in a little chapel. The pastor there was Frederic Brotherton Meyer. Moody spoke about his conversion in a shoe store, which changed Meyer's entire ministry...inspiring him to become an evangelist like Moody.

Meyer came to America. In Northfield, Massachusetts, a young preacher sitting in the back row heard Meyer say: "If you are not willing to give up everything for Christ, are you willing to be made willing?" That remark led J. Wilbur Chapman to respond to the call.

Chapman went on to become one of the most effective evangelists of his time. A volunteer for Chapman, by the name of Billy Sunday, helped set up the crusades and learned how to preach by watching Chapman. Sunday eventually took over Chapman's ministry, and became one of the most dynamic evangelists of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. His preaching turned thousands of people to Christ.

Inspired by Billy Sunday, in 1924 a group of Christians in Charlotte, North Carolina, dedicated themselves to reach that whole city for Christ. They invited Mordecai Ham to hold a series of evangelistic meetings in 1932. A lanky 16 year old sat in the huge crowd one evening, spellbound by the message Mordecai Ham delivered. The 16 year old went back for several nights, and finally went forward to give his life to Christ.

That teenager's name?...Billy Graham – the man who has undoubtedly communicated the gospel of Jesus Christ to more people than any other man in history.

Here is the amazing thing about the true story above: millions and millions of people have been affected by the decision of a Sunday School teacher to share the Gospel with one of his students. You probably don't think the simple things you do for the Lord matter all that much, right?

Really? How do you know? Your faithfulness added to God's intention just might be way more important that you will ever realize. So, keep on caring and keep on serving in your own humble way, who knows what God might do with your service.
