Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

On June 8, 1972, a 9 year old Vietnamese girl, her clothes flaming from chemical explosives, fled the American-led assault on her village of Trang Bang. With her eyes tightly shut and her mouth spread wide in a scream of pain, she was captured on film in what may be America's most remembered wartime photo from Vietnam.

In John Plummer's nightmares, this picture flashed huge, in black and white, to a sound track of children screaming. His order had directed bombers to attack Kim Phuc's village. For years, guilt over destroying and maiming the villagers haunted the officer. Women an alcohol were his escape of choice.

20 years after the destruction of the village, Officer Plummer asked Christ to take control of his life. He sought and found a forgiving God, but he carried inside himself the scars of that attack - just like Kim Phuc carried scars on her neck, arm and back. 6 years went by, and Plummer knew he needed to find her. In an effort to meet her face to face, he tracked her down while she was visiting the United States. Unlike the 1972 event, no photographer captured the moment when Plummer explained to Kim Phuc who he was. But in the middle of a busy sidewalk, a 49 year old soldier and a child, now 33 years old, embraced. "She just opened her arms to me," Plummer later said. "I fell into her arms sobbing." All I could say was: "I'm so sorry, I'm so sorry!" It's all right," she replied as she patted Plummer's back. "I forgive, I forgive."

Whatever you have done, no matter how bad it is, God can forgive it. "When we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9 And with God, it's never to late to ask. God waits patiently for you to come to him and seek forgiveness for your sins. For the sake of his Son, Jesus Christ, all of us are forgiven fully and freely. We are forgiven by grace. And we learn to live in the freedom that forgiveness brings as we forgive others. There is no psychology, no other theology, no course of therapy or self-help seminar, that can do what the cross of Jesus Christ can do with guilt from our own actions and with the resentments we hold for the actions of others. Only the cross of Jesus Christ can set us free. Jesus said: "If the Son sets you free, you are free indeed." John 8:36.

No matter how much time has passed, we can find freedom in forgiveness.
