I am excited to share with you some information about worship opportunities and about our goal of making 2013 "The Year of TRUTH and FREEDOM".

### WHEN LOVE SPEAKS

Jesus said: "Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends." John 15:13 (NIV) Jesus made that sacrifice for us on the cross. During the Sundays in Lent, beginning February 17<sup>th</sup>, we will follow a series of messages based on the 7 statements of Jesus from the cross. As we see Him love us enough to lay down His life for us, we will listen and learn "When Love Speaks". This series will conclude in our Holy Week services. The messages will have the following themes:

"A Word of Forgiveness" - Luke 23:32-37
"A Word of Assurance" - Luke 23:39-43
"A Word of Loving Care" - John 19:25-27
"A Word of Substitution" - Matthew 27:45-46
"A Word of Humanity" - John 19:28-29
"A Word of Victory" - John 19:30
"A Word of Trust" - Luke 23:44-47

#### MIDWEEK LENT DEVOTIONAL SERVICES

This year we will again enjoy the "family-style" devotional worship setting downstairs on the Wednesday evenings during Lent. The first devotional service will be on Ash Wednesday, February 13<sup>th</sup>. Our traditional Soup Supper will be from 5:30pm to 6:30pm. Our Devotional Worship will follow from 6:30pm until 7:00pm. (*Note: on Ash Wednesday we will celebrate Holy Communion which will make for a slightly longer service.*)

This year our devotions and discussion questions will come from John's Gospel. Almost half of the Gospel of John covers Holy Week. This year we will read a chapter of the Gospel each week, beginning with the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem and concluding the final week with Jesus' arrest. There will also be a couple of discussion questions each week for each table to share. From John's Gospel we gain insight into what happened, and insight into the heart and mind of our Savior. Plan to join us.


### 2013: The year of TRUTH and FREEDOM
