Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

A weak government and a weak economy have left many Americans feeling adrift. A lot of people feel defeated by the past, they feel discouraged about today, and they're kind of just drifting into tomorrow, into the future. I heard someone recently say: "I think it is our destiny to to continue to fall apart as a nation, it doesn't look like anything can change that."

Most people misunderstand the term "destiny." They think it means "an unalterable conclusion". They believe it means fate, kismet, or karma. They believe you can't change your destiny...that you can't control it...that you don't have anything to do with it. It's like they think that God predetermines your destiny and it's going to happen no matter what you do. That's what Islam teaches. That's what Buddhism teaches. That's not what Christianity teaches. God doesn't want you to just drift through life. He doesn't want you to waste your life.

In fact the Bible teaches two very important truths about your destiny. The first one is: God's destiny for my life is good. A lot of times people think their destiny is bad, it's negative, it's bitter. But the Bible says in Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV) "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord. 'Plans to prosper you and not harm you. Plans to give you hope and a future." (emphasis mine). God says "my plan, my destiny for your life is a good plan".

You may have had a terrible past. You may have had a painful past. But the truth is... the story isn't over. You haven't come to the end of the movie yet. God says His plan, His destiny for your life is good and it's going to give you hope.

The second thing is: I get to choose my destiny. Did you know that? The Bible says that you and I get to choose our destiny. God gives us a choice. In fact, you can miss the good destiny God has planned for you. It's not automatic. It's not just going to happen whether you want it to or not. It's not involuntary. You get to choose your ny. "I set before you today life and prosperity, or death and destruction. ... If you love the Lord your God and walk in his ways, and keep his commands, then you'll live and increase, and the Lord your God will bless you in the land you are entering to possess. BUT if your hearts turn away from me ...you will not live long in the land you are crossing the Jordan to enter and possess... I have set before you life or death, blessings or curses. Now CHOOSE LIFE, so that you and your children may live!" (emphasis mine). Deuteronomy 30:15-19 (NIV)

On July 14th we will begin a 4-part series entitled: "Preparing for Your Future". This is not just for recent uates, it is for God's people of any age. We will look to at how each of us can plug into the destiny God has created for us We will together explore how to prepare for the future that God wants you to live so that you're choosing life rather than death...choosing blessings rather than curses. The themes are as follows:
