Our new interim pastor, Robert Harmon, will be with us on Sunday, August 17th to lead us in both services. There will be a "get to know you" reception for Pastor Harmon between 9:00 and 10:00am. He will initially be with us for two and one half days per week. Please make him feel welcome. Until Pastor Harmon arrives, the services will be lead by members of the congregation.

Pastor Harmon is married with two children and resides in Aurora, Colorado. After graduating from University of Colorado, he became a mortgage broker and subsequently a commercial jet pilot. At the age of 35 he decided to pursue his passion for the ministry that he has had since childhood, and graduated from the LCMS seminary in Fort Wayne, Indiana in 2001. He has served congregations in Pueblo and Las Cruces. Currently he is a supply pastor in the Denver area.

Our call committee has completed the self survey tasks, and the information has been submitted to the Rocky Mountain District. I have spoken to the district president and he has already begun to compile a list of potential candidates. We should expect to get his list of 20-25 candidates for consideration by the beginning of September, along with nominations from the congregation. Once the list is received, the call committee will begin its evaluation process, and will submit a list of 3-5 candidates for consideration by the congregation, probably by the beginning of October.

Please continue to pray for the call committee, our congregation and the district staff as we proceed, that the Lord's will be done. We can be confident that he will provide.

- Net results YTD through June, although negative by \$12,908 is better than budget by \$10,226.
- Will move \$15,000 from savings to checking in July in anticipation of lower summer contributions.
