Playing 'Hooky'

When Jesus was twelve years old He got into trouble for playing 'hooky'. The second chapter of St. Luke's Gospel tells us that Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem when the family returned to Nazareth after the yearly festival. After three days of frantic searching, Mary and Joseph found the boy Jesus, in the temple, 'sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions' (Luke 2.46).

Wouldn't you know it, when Jesus plays hooky, He actually runs away to go to Sunday School! When Jesus' mom chews Him out in verse 48, it is for going to church! "Son, why have you treated us like this? Your father and I have been anxiously searching for you."

This is a timely message for you rebellious types out there. You who are adolescent at heart and enjoy pushing your mother's buttons. Try something new this year and see if you can get Mom to chew you out for doing something *different*. Go ahead, rebel, ruffle Mom's feathers and get caught playing hooky at Sunday School, youth group or Adult Bible Class! And for those of you who want to go the extra mile, forget the tattoo, attend a mid week Bible study instead or maybe start a small group Bible Study at your house!

Lest anyone feel left out, a brief word to the 'non-rebellious' is in order.

Jesus Christ, the divine Son of God, second Person of the Trinity and the One whom the Holy Spirit defines as, 'the Word made flesh' (John 1.14), still found it worthwhile to sit at the feet of the teachers in the temple, 'listening and asking questions' (Luke 2.46). The One who is the very embodiment of the Scriptures, still found it profitable, to go to Sunday School.

So even if you're not one of the congregations rebel's, there is still a seat for you at the Sunday School table. Even if you were the head of your confirmation class, the kid who always did your memory work and read the workbook assignments without being told—even you will profit from gathering together with other believers around God's message of love and forgiveness for all the world, for Jesus' sake.
