COMING TOGETHER FOR THE SUMMER

Last month, as you read this Newsletter, I gave emphasis to *unity in the community*. I'm sure you will not be surprised to notice the word *community* as a potential combination of the two words *common* and *unity*. This is the very nature of a *community* ... we hold in *common* and do so in *unity*.

If you were to read again what I shared last month, what we hold in *common* and in *unity* is the Word of God. This, most certainly, is the Scriptures. This, more certainly, is the Lord Jesus. Both are known as the Word of God. Our study of the Revelation, which has now drawn to a close, focused us on both – Jesus in the Scriptures.

Where to go from here? Let me suggest two directions. First, in keeping with the decision of the Adult Bible Study group that meets on Sunday morning, we will begin a reading of Acts. This will draw us into the life and work of God's People under the authority of the living Lord Jesus. This, however, will not just be an historical study of the Church's first 35 years or so. Along the way, we will also explore each of the New Testament letters within their historical context, giving us a fuller and more mature application of the Word for our world today.

Everyone is invited as we read, discuss and study God's Work among God's People.

The second direction includes everyone as well! As an expression of our *common-unity* together, let's agree to read a book together. I'll call this a Summer Book Club. The book I'd like to read with you is *Grace Upon Grace: Spirituality for Today* by John Kleinig. My hope is that we'll make this - *common* - a summer reading project that will culminate in a celebratory discussion - *unity* - as the summer draws to a close. Since there are a variety of places you can purchase this book, I'll let you choose whatever is best for you. Let's start reading.

So many of you have commented: "Now this is the season to live in Steamboat!" Sheryl and I are certainly inclined to agree. So, in this beautiful time of year, I look forward to seeing you as we gather on Sundays and elsewhere. I most certainly ask the Lord's blessing upon you and your family as I also ask the Father's favor in giving the Holy Spirit to be among us.
