The Revelation of Jesus Christ is one of my favorite writings of the Bible. In this final teaching of the New Testament, John of Ephesus is privileged to "peek beyond the thin veil that separates the heavens and the earth," seeing and hearing the Reality that stands behind and within our reality. As the Vision draws to a close, he sees *"a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and there is no longer any sea"* (Rev. 21).

Ponder with me for a moment: new heavens and a new earth are in our future replacing the old heavens and the old earth! One goes away – the old – and another arrives – the new. One – the new – replaces the other – the old. One – the old – is worn and used, fragmented and broken. The other – the new – is fresh and unused, unified and beautiful.

This is as it was meant to be and will be; after all, *"the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God."* As the dwelling place of both God and His people, the new heavens and the new earth must be spectacular! I can't wait; such a hope keeps me motivated and moving!

Till then, we have some important reasons to gather with one another in the coming month:

On **April 13th**, we will gather with Jesus as He offers Himself to us in the Sacrament. We will begin at 7:00pm.

On **April 14th**, we will commemorate Good Friday. On this day, we will remember and experience God's full and final judgment on the "old heavens and old earth." On this day, we will observe humanity doing our best to rid ourselves once and for all of the Living God, and doing our worst to the one Person who rescues us from ourselves. We'll begin at 7:00pm.

On **April 16th**, we will celebrate Resurrection! On this day, we will do more than just remember; we will actively participate in the inauguration of the New Creation. On this day, we will observe the Living God doing His best work, dealing absolutely with our worst. We'll begin at 6:30am and continue at 8:00am and 10:30am.

Ponder with me for a moment: the new heavens and new earth are among us now! With the pouring out of the Holy Spirit, God dwells with His people! Eternity and Eternal Life have begun. Your baptism drew you into the Resurrection of the Christ. What is His is yours!

Still, let us not forget the creation in which we live. Yes, we are "new creations in Christ," but we are still "old creations in Adam." What are we to make of the creation as we now experience it? How does the creation fit into our lives? How does the Gospel relate to the creation? How can we – as an expression of faith – care for the creation in our personal and congregational lives?
