On this day, 500 years ago, a spark had been ignited that would transform the world. The posting of the 95 Theses was the spark that led to changes in theology, culture, education and life. While this was not the first of the reform efforts, Luther's "sentences-for-debates" paved the way for a variety of political, social and theological transformations.

You can read the 95 Theses, looking them up online. Here are the first four theses:

- 1. When our Lord and Master Jesus Christ said, "Repent" (Mt 4:17), he willed the entire life of believers to be one of repentance.
- 2. This word cannot be understood as referring to the sacrament of penance, that is, confession and satisfaction, as administered by the clergy.
- 3. Yet it does not mean solely inner repentance; such inner repentance is worthless unless it produces various outward mortification of the flesh.
- 4. The penalty of sin remains as long as the hatred of self (that is, true inner repentance), namely till our entrance into the kingdom of heaven.

These are important statements, taking a life-time of reflective Bible study to wrestle with and apply. These four comments engulfed and engaged Martin Luther the rest of his life. The same is to be true of Lutherans today! We never stop nor give up learning from Jesus!

Last Sunday, as we remembered and celebrated the 500th anniversary of the posting of the 95 Theses, we were privileged to have the Steamboat Springs High School String Ensemble among us. Their talent was obvious; their willingness to serve and support is commendable. We hope to have them back in the future!

As I commented, their presence as "musicians in symphony" form a good metaphor for the Christian Church. If you had heard them tuning and warming up, you would have wondered if any good sound would be heard. The same is true in every congregation: when members do their own thing, the result isn't that loving nor lovely, sometimes squeaking before the culture.

But, when the Director draws the ensemble together, giving them guidance, emphasizing the musical score with each instrument adding to the total presentation, the results are nothing short of amazing. Individual talents, when combined, create a remarkable presence and exceptional experience. The same is true in every congregation: when members, under Christ, offer their talents/resources in symphony (each playing their part), the results are lovely and loving.

On November 15th, another class will be offered to encourage and support Concordia's symphony-in-Christ. Knowing that you want our congregation to be together in harmony (each playing our part) with melody (playing our parts together), I am inviting you to join with me for our next session of "Christian Vocation and Gift-Based Ministry."

We'll be at the church, beginning at 6:00pm on Wednesday, November 15th. See you there!
