Christ is risen! Hallelujah!

The celebration of Easter – Resurrection – continues. Several asked me on Monday, "How was your Easter?" My response was, "My Easter is still good!"

Why do I say that? I say it this way because I want to communicate the reality that Easter – The Resurrection of Jesus the Christ – is not a one-time celebration. Sunday's festivities are not a one-and-done event. Resurrection, as experienced by Jesus of Nazareth, is but the beginning. Read how Paul announces this reality:

But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. But each in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ. (1 Corinthians 15:20-23)

The earliest Christian communities had much to wrestle with. They were convinced something had happened that radically altered the way they viewed the world. This "something" was the Resurrection of their Master and Teacher, Jesus. Peter, James and John (to name a few), lived the rest of their lives dealing with and discovering the implications of Easter.

In fact, as the Scriptures reveal, "resurrection" continues! Read how John records what Jesus revealed to him:

They came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. This is the first resurrection.

(Revelation 20:4-5)

There is much to ponder here for sure. The point I want us to focus on is the stated fact that "they came to life" and "they reigned with Christ" during the intervening time between the First and Second Comings of Jesus. When did you "come to life" and when did you "begin to reign" with Christ? At your Baptism. This is your resurrection … the first one! The Second Resurrection is yet to come!

Paul reminds: Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.

(1 Corinthians 15:58)

Can you look at your phone in the same way? "My Easter is still good!" Yours?
