"Live the long board!" became the clarion call of the Adult Bible Study last Sunday. This happened for two reasons:

First, you will recall my use of two boards last Sunday to illustrate Jesus' two promises: "In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world." The short board presented the trials and troubles we will experience in this world. The long board presented the Way of Love flowing from the victory of Jesus over the world.

Second, in our Adult Bible Study, we are now beginning a study of 1 Corinthians 15. This is one of Paul's greatest reflections upon the meaning, reality and purpose of Resurrection. In fact, as we began with the first few verses, the Resurrection of Jesus is the inauguration of the long board.

I'll be sure to introduce the two boards again this Sunday, reminding us of the two "worlds" in which Christians daily live. I will offer further insight into the "tribulations" that we face in this world ... the short board ... which is determined to limp along apart from the wisdom and guidance of the Holy Spirit.

And, I will invite you to join with me as Jesus prays! As you can in the next few days, do read the High Priestly Prayer of Jesus as recorded in John 17. We will focus on the final section of His prayer, listening in as Jesus prays for us! When Jesus prays for us, what does He ask for? What are His main points? What does He want to see happen in the world today? How does Jesus' praying help us pray? Since Jesus prays for the long board, we can learn to do the same.

Within this important message comes REPS: Reaching Everyone Preventing Suicide. This is an important organization in our community that specifically "seeks to preserve, protect and promote life by providing the Yampa Valley with a group of trained volunteers, collaborative initiatives, educational programs, compassionate survivor-care and proactive suicide prevention." "Live the long board!" can become the clarion call of Concordia. Let's pray with Jesus for just such an outcome.
