Blessings to you, dearest brothers, and sisters in the Lord!

We have entered the Advent Season. The word *advent* means "the arrival of a notable person, thing, or event." While we do not use the word *advent* in our everyday vocabulary, we do use phrases like the "arrival of spring," or "the *appearance* of the full moon" and "making an entrance" or "here comes the snow."

The English word *advent* is the Latin word *adventus*, meaning "coming." *Adventus* is the translation of the Greek word *parousia*. This word was commonly used in the first century to talk about the coming of the emperor, ruler, or king. *Parousia*, in the Bible, refers to the second coming of Christ in Glory.

For Christians, the Season of Advent anticipates the coming of Christ from two different perspectives. Throughout the Advent Season, we share in the ancient longing for the coming of the Messiah, and, in keeping with the command of the Christ, we remain vigilant and alert for his Second Coming.

As we engage this year's Advent Season, we will reflect upon the many struggles we face as Christians in the world today. Recognizing that these battles just might continue, our theme for Advent 2021 is "Ready for the Battles Ahead of Us." We will be looking at how the LORD our God prepares us for such struggles by giving us the right and proper "armor." Ephesians 6:10-18 will be our focus.

Many think that Paul is using the Roman soldier as an example to encourage us to engage and remain in the battle-struggles we face. This might be true but seems to diminish the full imagery Paul is drawing from. More likely, Paul, a well-trained and zealous Pharisee (former Pharisee?) is far better trained in Old Testament reality than Roman warfare.

So, we are going to investigate how God makes us ready to face the battle-struggles by dressing us as Warrior-Priests. You can join with us each of the next three Wednesdays (December 1, 8, and 15) to discover how God dresses us in the full "armor" of the "priest of God." Our Soup Suppers will begin at 5:30pm followed by our 6:30pm Advent Service. See you here!
