Dearest Sisters and Brothers,

"Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell together!" (Psalm 133:1 ESV). I fully agree! Let me quickly explore the images David highlights:

GOOD: think about what is working in your life the way it is designed to work and is supposed to work, some plan or relationship that is functioning just as you would expect. When we come across such "win, win" situations, we call them "good, pleasant, agreeable, excellent, valuable, appropriate, beneficial, prosperous."

PLEASANT: think about what is agreeable to you, what is satisfying and makes you content. We would use words like "pleasant, delightful, sweet, lovely, agreeable, delightful, beautiful" to describe such experiences. This is the idea of "now that's music to my ears," something we might say when we hear of some good news.

DWELL: think of a time when you took the time to just sit with someone, to be present to them, being with them fully and freely. This is "abiding, remaining, staying, living" with them in awareness.

TOGETHER: think of an experience when you were with someone else and your conversations and tasks felt like you were "on the same page." There was an abundant sense of "unity, harmony, connectedness" that was enjoyed as being united for a common purpose and effort(s).

David declares, under the guiding influence of the Holy Spirit, that "dwelling together" is "good and pleasant." I also experience "dwelling together in unity" that is "good and pleasant." I experience it at the recent Elder and the Parish Council meetings. I experience it every Sunday during our Divine Services and our Adult Bible Study. I experience it at home every day. If you were to look around your life, I think you would find such experiences as well.

I look forward to our relationships, our efforts, our lives together!
